Assembly Instructions

1. Select a level area to operate with plenty of room to allow for a line to form.
2. Slide the valance onto one of the B pipes.
3. Slide a black drape onto two of the E pipes.
4. Slide two of the black drapes onto one of the B pipes.
5. Assemble framework, per sketch. Be sure to tighten down the fittings using the small bolts on them.
6. Slide the backdrops on the backdrop poles (pipe A). Place the backdrop poles on the top of the unit toward the back.
7. If using outdoors, it is strongly suggested that you use the stakes provided on either side of the bottom supports. Use sandbags on pavement. We strongly advise against using in a breeze.
8. Never store wet. Always allow to dry thoroughly before storing.

Canvas Care

1. If game becomes wet, dry thoroughly before storing.
2. Roll up the backdrops (with image side in) to help protect and keep it clean.
3. Store backdrops in the tote bag.




